About This Test

When treating fever, doctors focus on alleviating symptoms and addressing the underlying cause. Antipyretics like acetaminophen (Tylenol) or ibuprofen (Advil) are commonly prescribed to reduce fever and relieve discomfort. Dosage is based on the patient's age, weight, and the severity of the fever. Hydration is critical, as fever can lead to dehydration, so patients are encouraged to drink fluids regularly. In cases where the fever is caused by bacterial infections, antibiotics are prescribed, while antiviral medications may be used for viral infections. If the fever is due to inflammation or an autoimmune disorder, corticosteroids or other immunosuppressive medications might be needed. Mild fevers can be managed with over-the-counter treatments and rest, but persistent or high fevers (above 103°F/39.4°C) require medical attention, particularly in infants, the elderly
