The Serum Ascites Albumin Gradient (SAAG) measures the difference in albumin concentration between the serum and ascitic fluid. This test helps determine the cause of ascites, which is fluid accumulation in the abdominal cavity. A high SAAG (greater than 1.1 g/dL) suggests that the ascites is due to portal hypertension, commonly caused by liver cirrhosis or congestive heart failure. A low SAAG indicates that ascites is due to non-portal hypertensive conditions, such as infections or malignancies.
